Plymouth Philharmonic Orchestra Music Scholarship Selection Process

- The Scholarship Committee reviews applications and invites up to five (5) students to an interview.
- The Scholarship Committee, with the advice and consent of the Plymouth Philharmonic Music Director, conducts interviews with up to five (5) finalist candidates and selects one (1) who receives the scholarship.
- Interview candidates will be judged on a broad set of criteria including, presentation, future goals, focus, motivation, and musical achievements. A candidate may submit a portfolio of programs, school news articles, brief audio or video clips, but these materials are optional to the process.

Scholarship Award

- The Plymouth Philharmonic Orchestra will make a direct payment to the organization, instructor, or retail establishment chosen by the scholarship winner. After receiving an invoice, the Plymouth Philharmonic Orchestra will complete the payment within 30 days.
- All expenses must be incurred and paid for within one (1) year of the award date.
- The Committee reserves the right not to award a scholarship when its members agree there is not a suitable candidate.
